## You can say 'You' to me: What to consider when teaching in English

Prof. Dr. Anne-Marie Elbe, Sports Psychology

Professor Elbe illustrates why English-language teaching is important for the development of students' professional competencies as well as for the advancement of study programmes and faculties.
